REQUIREMENTS

At the University of California, Berkeley parking is a scarcity. There are not enough parking spaces for all of the faculty, staff, and students who work, study and live on campus. Therefore, a limited number of spaces have been allocated to the residents on the basis of demonstrated compelling need.

<u>City of Berkeley Residential Permit Parking. The City of Berkeley</u> restricts street parking to a time limit of two hours. Only residential permit holders may leave their cars on the street for a longer period. Students living in the residence halls are NOT eligible to receive permits from the City of Berkeley.

How Do I Qualify For A Parking Space? Parking spaces are allocated to students living in the residence halls only. Parking with this permit is restricted to assigned RH lots.

- 1. Complete the Parking Policy and Application.
- 2. Submit a copy of your Housing contract
- (submit email confirmation okay)

Residence Hall Parking. Residence Hall Parking Permits can only be purchased on an annual basis, 7/11/xx - 6/30/xx. Further instructions regarding permit privileges will be provided to approved applicants who are granted a Residence Hall Parking Permit at the time of purchase. See pt.berkeley.edu for pricing.
